## **II INFORMATION REGARDING THE OPEN POSITION**

**according to Article 3, Paragraph (5) of Government Resolution 457/2011**

### **A. Description of the open position:**

The open position for an associate professor is registered as vacancy nr. 13 in the Staff Establishment of the Legal and Administrative Sciences Department approved for the academic year 2016-2017, with the following disciplines: Commercial Law 1, Commercial Law 2 with lecture and tutorial activities. The open position includes:

- Commercial Law discipline with 2 lecture hours + 1 seminar hours/week/1<sup>st</sup> semester for the university bachelor's degree program;
- Commercial Law discipline with 2 lecture hours + 1 seminar hours/week/2<sup>nd</sup> semester for the university bachelor's degree program.

### **B. Job description of the open position. Tasks and duties including teaching load and types of activities**

1. To teach lectures, seminars and projects, according to the curriculum and discipline sheet.
2. To assess students during the course and final examination.
3. Coordinate students' practical activities.
4. Coordinate students' scientific papers
5. Scientific coordination of the license thesis/ dissertation.
6. To participate in the research activity of the department.
7. To write and publish lectures, monographs, articles or scientific studies.

## **F. Description of the competition procedure:**

See the own contest methodology for occupying teaching positions and research positions at The Ecological University of Bucharest.

The contest consists in evaluating of scientific activity and teaching qualities. According to the article 23 of The EUB Competition Framework Methodology, the contest commission evaluate the candidate from the perspective of the following:

- a) the relevance and the scientific impact of the candidate;
- a) the candidate's ability to guide students and young researchers;
- b) the candidate's teaching skills;
- c) the candidate's ability to transfer its own knowledge and results to the economic or social environment or to disseminate its own scientific results;
- d) the candidate's ability to work in a team and efficiency of its scientific collaborations, depending on candidate's specific domain;

- e) the candidate's ability to conduct research and development projects;
- f) the candidate's professional experience in other institutions than the institution that put out in the contest the position.

Professional skills of the candidate are evaluated by the contest commission based on the contest brief and, additionally, through one or more contest tasks, including lectures, courses or other alike. According to EUB Methodology and The EUB Faculty of Law and Administration Regulation, assessing the candidate's professional competences is based on the contest brief, whether it is about a lecturer, associate professor or professor.

Additionally, for the post of Lecturer, the candidates will also sustain:

- A written test, which consists of examining knowledge in the specialized area for the registered position;
- A 30-60 minute lecture in which the candidate presents its previous professional results and academic career development plan.

Additionally, for the associate professor and professor positions, the candidates will hold a practical examination, which consists of a 30-60 minute lecture (on a subject listed of the contest topics), followed by 15 -30 minutes discussions on the lecture title.

#### **G. The full list of documents that candidates must include in their application files:**

1. **Cover page**
2. **OPIS**
3. **Application** signed by the candidate, including a self-declaration that certifies the truth and accuracy of the information provided by the candidate.
4. A **proposal for developing the candidate's academic career** both in terms of teaching, and in terms of scientific research; the proposal, of no more than 10 pages, must be drawn up by the candidate and is one of the main criteria to distinguish between applicants.
5. The applicant's **Curriculum Vitae** both in printed and electronic form, that must include:
  - a. information about education and degrees;
  - b. information about professional experience and relevant jobs;
  - c. information regarding the research-development projects - that they conducted as project managers and grants they obtained, if such projects or grants exist, indicating for each of them the source and the amount of funding and the main resulting publications and patents
  - d. information about the awards or other recognition of the scientific contribution of the candidate.
6. The candidate's **List of papers** in printed and electronic form, structured as follows:
  - a. the list of maximum 10 papers considered by the candidates to be the most relevant for their professional achievements, which will be included in the file in electronic form.
  - b. PhD thesis or theses;
  - c. patents and other industrial property rights;
  - d. books and chapters in books;

- e. articles/studies *in extenso* published in the main international scientific journals;
- f. publications *in extenso*, issued in publications of the most important international scientific conferences;
- g. other works and scientific contributions

**7. The Verification Sheet** stating the fulfilment of the competition standards required by the Ecological University of Bucharest's own methodology, filled in and signed by the candidate

**8. Documents related to the possession of a doctoral degree:** a certified copy of the Ph.D. degree and, if the original PhD degree was obtained abroad, the certificate of recognition or equivalence thereof.

**9. The Summary** of the doctoral dissertation in Romanian and in a widely spread foreign language, no more than one page for each language.

**10. The self-declaration** of the candidate indicating situations of incompatibility according to Law no. 1/2011

**11. Copies of other certificates** attesting the applicant's studies: high school, undergraduate, masters, studies certificates, etc.

**12. Copy of the identity card** or, if the candidate does not have an identity card, a copy of the passport or other valid identity document issued for the same purpose as the identity card or passport.

**13.** If the candidate has changed his or her name, copies of documents certifying the change of name - **marriage certificate** or proof of the change of name.

**14. Maximum 10 publications, patents or other works of the candidate**, in electronic form, selected by the candidate and considered as the most relevant for their professional achievements. The candidate's works that are not available in electronic format: course books, treaties, articles in accredited scientific journals, certificates of participation in congresses, symposiums, scientific sessions will be presented in written form.
